# 2 Months Until the Brazil Mission Trip!

Kids and adult volunteers are busy getting passports, yellow fever, typhoid, and malaria vaccines and medications, and all the other items they will need as they journey to the the Amazon Rainforest on July 13. They will be flying out of the Columbus Airport with a layover in Miami before the final leg to Manaus, Brazil, landing after midnight (on July 14). They will be met by ADRA staff who will put them on a bus and shuttle them about an hour away to the ADRA base camp along the Amazon River. Either on arrival, or in the morning, they will load

up on the river boats and head upstream to a village where they will begin a week of hard work! At the end of the week they will get a fun day where they will get the opportunity to swim with the pink river dolphins, see giant



lily pads, eat out at a restaurant (which is said to have a troup of monkey's living outside), and shop in the local market. On July 22, around 1am, our group will fly out of

Manaus and head back to Miami where there is a short layover, and then back to Columbus by late morning. Please pray for the group going to Brazil that they will touch the lives there for Jesus and that everyone will be safe and remain healthy! ##

#### **Battle Plan Church Chat**

I am so proud of a couple Toledo First Church members who recently gave me permission to share that they are struggling with addiction to smoking and alcohol. They don't want to be but they are! They know all too well that the devil "Prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour" (1 Peter 5:8). One of them came up with the courageous idea to ask the

church to pray for them to be able to quit! So a couple of months ago in the middle of March, that's what she did! During church she introduced herself and confessed her

addiction and asked for help. She passed out a card she called "Battle Plan Church Chat."

The card, she said, is a way to encourage her by texting on your mobile phone. By filling the card out with your contact info and placing the card in the offering plate or returning it to the church office, you indicate your willingness to share via text a Scriptural promise or word of encouragement at a specific time each day. Options included 7-8am, noon-1pm, or 7-8pm. So the cards were distributed and people responded on them and now she is receiving those daily prayers and texts but there is always room for more people to participate. Are you willing to help? If you are, please notify the church office (419.882.6200; office@toledofirstadventist.org) that you're willing to join the Battle Plan Church Chat and specify what time you prefer to participate and we will connect you with the correct name and number.
